



What do I do when I get stuck?

Talk to your child about what they do when they get stuck or they don't know what to do.

Using the spider diagram in the activities folder create a list of ideas (using words and pictures). Make a poster to put on the wall so you and your child can refer to this when reading, writing, doing homework etc.

Feel free to be creative- make your own diagram using colours. Make it big and bold!

Why are we doing this?

If a child knows what to do when they are stuck and the steps they can take to help themselves before they start they will feel more confident and willing to have a go.

By going over these strategies multiple times they will use the ideas more and more and form a habit.

At school we use a range of phrases to remind the children:

'Brain, Board, Buddy.'

'Think it, say it, write it, read it.'
