Year 3 – Day Visit to PACCAR, Chalfont St Peter on Monday 6th July 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to offer Year 3 children the opportunity to experience a visit to PACCAR Activity Centre, a Scouts activity centre based in Chalfont St Peter, <https://paccarscoutcamp.org>

Year 3 staff will select a range of activities for the children to enjoy and will share details with the children nearer the time. Qualified instructors give all tuition and the day programme will be designed to offer children a taste of pursuits that they may not have previously experienced. The aim of this trip is to develop the children's resilience and team building skills, by giving them new challenges and experiences. For health and safety reasons, the children will be divided into 4 groups for the day. Each group will have the opportunity to try 3 or 4 activities – details of activities are yet to be confirmed. The activities for each group cannot be exactly the same but they will be similar and will allow them to develop the same skills. We are sure you will support us in explaining this to the children.

To cover the costs of this trip we are asking for a **voluntary contribution from parents of £33 per child**.

You are able to give consent and make your voluntary contributions on ParentPay – please look for the trip payment item "Year 3 PACCAR 2026".

The deadline for giving consent and for voluntary contributions to be made is Friday 17th April 2026.

As the centre is close by, and to keep costs down, we ask that parents arrange transport to and from PACCAR Scout Camp.

Children should be dropped at the main entrance to PACCAR between 09:15 and 09:30 on Monday 6th July and children should be collected from the same place at 15:40. The Activity Session Timings are from 10:00 to 15:30. Please park in the main car park and walk your child towards the large wooden building to your left and the entrance to the large field where you will be met by CSG staff. Please do not allow your children to walk across the car park alone as it gets very busy. If you are not collecting your child please let the office know who is your nominated adult to collect from PACCAR.

Children should dress in weather appropriate, comfortable clothing suitable to being active outside all day. We would recommend that they wear comfortable footwear such as trainers. Depending on the weather the children may need sunhats and to have applied suncream at home. Children will need a water bottle for the day; a low waste packed lunch to include a drink; a morning snack and an afternoon snack - nothing sticky please (and no fizzy drinks). All items that the children take should be clearly labelled.

Directions: Postcode for Satnavs is **SL9 0QH**. Approaching Chalfont St Peter on the A413 from Amersham turn left up Joiners Lane (at the Greyhound Roundabout). Turn right at the T Junction onto Denham Lane. The entrance to PACCAR Scout Camp is on the right (just past Winkers Farm Country Club). If you have problems making payment via ParentPay please contact the school office. While this is a voluntary contribution, if we do not receive a sufficient sum the event will have to be cancelled since we cannot cover the cost from school funds.
