Year 4 – Day Visit to Woodrow High House, Amersham Friday 5th June 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to offer Year 4 children the opportunity to experience a day visit to Woodrow High House, an activity centre near Amersham. <https://woodrowhighhouse.org/> ..

The activities run from 9am to 5pm. As the centre is close by and to keep costs down, we ask that parents arrange transport to and from Woodrow High House.

The children will be divided into 4 groups for the day. Each group will have the opportunity to try 4 activities – details of activities are yet to be confirmed but we will work closely with the team at Woodrow to choose a good balance of activities. Qualified instructors give all tuition and the programme is designed to offer children a taste of pursuits that they may not have previously experienced. The aim of this trip is to develop the children's resilience and team building skills by giving them new challenges and experiences.

*To cover the costs of this trip we are asking for a **voluntary contribution from parents of £63.00 per child.** This is a voluntary contribution but if we do not receive sufficient funds to cover costs then the trip will not be able to go ahead.*

We need **four** parent helpers to accompany us on the visit. If you are able to help on this trip and have a DBS check valid for our school, please can you contact the School Office. We shall contact you to let you know if you will be needed or not but please note that it is school policy that you will **not** be responsible for the group of children that your child is in.

You are able to give consent and make your voluntary contribution on ParentPay – look for the trip payment item – *Year 4 Woodrow 2026* for £63. The deadline for giving consent and for voluntary contributions to be made by Friday 27th February 2026

Children should be dropped at the main entrance to Woodrow High House between 8:30am and 8:45am on Friday 5th June and children should be collected from the same place at 5pm. Please park in the main car park and walk your child to the front of the house where they will be met and registered by CSG staff. Please do not allow your children to walk across the car park alone as it gets very busy.

Children should dress in weather appropriate, comfortable clothing suitable to being active outside all day. We would recommend that they wear comfortable footwear such as trainers (an old pair that you don't mind getting muddy). Depending on the weather the children may need sunhats and to have applied sunscreen at home.

Children will need a water bottle for the day; a low waste packed lunch to include a drink (no fizzy drinks). All items that the children take should be clearly labelled.

Directions: Pop the following postcode in your Satnav (HP7 0QG) and approach Cherry Lane from the A404, not through Amersham. Woodrow High House is situated on the A404 two miles from Amersham. Cherry Lane is the second turning on the right-hand side as you approach the top of the hill (signposted to Shardeloes Equestrian Centre).

If you have problems making payment via ParentPay please contact the school office. While this is a voluntary contribution, if we do not receive a sufficient sum the event will have to be cancelled since we cannot cover the cost from school funds.

As part of the trip organisation process you are asked to give consent for your child to attend the visit. Parents are also reminded to inform the school regarding any changes to the medical condition and other considerations of your child including any changes to emergency contact numbers.
