As part of Year 5's RE topic this term (Places of Worship), we shall be visiting two different churches on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2026. The two churches are [Gold Hill Baptist Church](#) (The Hub) and [Chalfont St Peter Parish Church](#) – both in Chalfont St Peter.

We will leave the school site at 9am, after morning registration, and walk to Chalfont St Peter. The children will walk as a year group, before separating into Maple and Beech Classes to look around the respective churches. If the weather is fine the children will have lunch in the Millennium Park close to the churches or if not in one of the churches before returning on foot to school.

If the weather is warm, please ensure that your child has sun cream on and a hat; if it is colder or raining, please ensure that your child has an appropriate coat to stay warm and dry. Please also ensure that your child has a packed lunch and a comfortable bag in which to carry their food and water.***

In order for the trip to go ahead, we will need four parent helper volunteers. If you hold a current Bucks Council DBS and would like to volunteer to come on the trip with us, please let the School Office know by email as soon as possible.

As part of the trip organising process you are asked to give consent for your child to attend the visit. Parents are also reminded to inform the school regarding any changes to the medical conditions and other considerations of your child including any changes to emergency contact numbers.

First Aid Kit items – please inform the office if we may not use any of the listed items for your child: Calpol 6+ (liquid suspension or Fast Melts); Piriton (antihistamine syrup); Anthisan (Antihistamine Bite and Sting Cream); Aqueous Calamine Cream; Vaseline, AntiBac Hand Sanitiser
