The children will be working in their classes, on a range of activities away from our normal timetable and you are welcome to join them in these and have the chance to be involved in the learning of the children and see our school at work.

The session will take place between 9:15am and 11am on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> May.

**To avoid overcrowding in the classrooms, we are offering two time slots - Slot One from 9:15am to 10am and Slot Two from 10:15am to 11am.**

The booking system for the Family Day will be available on ParentPay from today until Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May.

To book, please look in your ParentPay account under Trips.

Payment items will start with Family Day followed by Class name and a time – ie *Family Day Oak 915am*.

Please note that you only need to sign up for one slot even if you have two or more children. You will be able to move between classes in that slot

If you have problems using ParentPay please let the office know.

During the Family Day event the PTA Cafe will be open in the main school hall from 9:15am to 11am. Children must be supervised by an adult at all times. The supervising adult should return the children directly to the classroom after visiting the PTA café.

In order to keep your children safe, we will keep all gates locked except for the main entrance gate at Parsonage Road. Please enter the school at this entrance and sign in at the school office.

Local residents and the school request that you refrain from parking in Parsonage Road. We ask that visitors do not use any mobile phones and/or cameras whilst on the school premises.
