## Super Science Spotter Challenge

Following on from our previous challenges, we are excited to launch our next Super Science Spotter Challenge! This term's theme is "**Mission to the Moon.**"

We would like the children to explore the fascinating journey to the Moon and what it's like in space. The challenge is to find out at least 5 interesting facts about the Moon or space travel - for example, how astronauts travel to the Moon, what the surface of the Moon is like, how astronauts live and work in space, why the Moon has craters, or how gravity is different there.

You might also want to find out about NASA's **Artemis programme**, which is part of NASA's ongoing plan to return humans to the Moon. The programme has already completed an uncrewed test flight (Artemis I) and future missions will send astronauts around and eventually back onto the lunar surface, including the first woman and next man to land on the Moon.

Children can present their findings in any creative way they choose - a poster, model, mini-booklet, poem, fact file or any other way they would like.

The challenge will run for the whole of June and every child who takes part will receive a certificate in assembly to celebrate their scientific curiosity.

Children who complete all three challenges over the year will also earn a special science award.
